This scholarship of € 11,000.- per study year under the patronage of Excellency Sviatlana Tsikhanouskaya supports non EU nationals from Belarus and other Eastern European countries engaged in activities related to this important task by allowing them to study at a reduced tuition fee of EUR 1,500.- per year (tuition fee for Executive Master programs may vary).

The scholarship is applicable for the full standard period of the respective study program. It will be conferred for the first year based on the scholarship selection process and can be annually extended depending on academic performance and engagement.
